Who's teaching? Craig Knowles (PetSmarts Top Area Trainer) has been involved with the sport of flyball for the past fifteen years. Starting with his first team, Fast Track, out of Brampton, Ontario to the Region 1 Champions Slammers. In his time he has been an invaluable part of breaking fifteen world records with such teams as Rude Dogs, Springloaded, and currently Slammers. Working and competing with the best trainers in the sport has led Craig into developing different cutting edge techniques to get the best out of any dog. Craig's beliefs are in starting dogs young, laying essential ground work, using positive reinforcement, and making the training fun and rewarding for the dog. Playing flyball should be an enjoyable time with your dog, family, and friends and you should be able to compete at any level.

Kristie Schultz (Licensed Veterinary Technician) started her flyball career with her first dog, Splash, at the age of twelve years old and became hooked at that early age. Since then she has listened and learned from her friends and some of the top competitors in the sport. Combining their knowledge and her own techniques, she has maximized her canine competitors performance. Realizing that every dog is different and requires individual assessment, she uses positive reinforcement to help reach each dogs maximum potential. Her main belief is that any dog has the potential to compete, the trick is to bring out the desire.

Craig and Kristie currently share their home with eighteen dogs, thirteen that they actively compete with, four retired, and one young dog in training. They own, bred, handled, and helped train all of the dogs on their team that won Region One 2008 and 2009, National Champion Runner Up 2008, and post their personal best time of 15.53 seconds in 2009. While most of their dogs compete at the highest level, all are a major part of their family and live in their home. The combination of both Craig and Kristie's training techniques have brought forth the maximum potential of all the dogs they trained. Craig and Kristie also share their home with son, Jacob, and daughter Taylor, their five year old twins who often help in the training of their canine companions.
